

CODE OF ETHICS

This Code of Ethics applies to all cases not covered by the Golf Rules, the Footgolf Rules, the Federal Competition Rules or the Competition Rules. In the event of an overlap, the original rules will apply, but the club penalties will not be ignored. Footgolf players are not subject to special golf rules, but all other regulations are applied.

DRESS CODE

Only impeccably dressed players are allowed on the golf course.

- Tracksuits, military style and patterned trousers, and combat clothing, coveralls, overalls, workwear, swimwear - in any type and color are not acceptable as trousers.
- Only collared top clothing covering the entire upper body may be worn.
- Tops for ladies with or without sleeves, without back or straps are not allowed even in the driving range.
- Golf shoes (with soft stops), running shoes or soft-soled shoes are allowed.
- Shoes with heels higher than 1 cm, boots and beach loafers are prohibited.

The dress etiquette is highly recommended on the driving range but not required. For non-golfers the dress etiquette is not required in the clubhouse, and the on the terrace.

MINIMUM AGE

There is no age restriction on the use of the golf course. However, children under the age of 12 may only play on the court if accompanied by a responsible adult.

THE SPEED OF THE GAME

Keep a one-stroke tracking distance behind the group in front of you. The normal playing time of the track is 80 minutes.

Rules applied on teeing-ground

- Do not bring a golf cart, a trolley or an electric car to the tee, do your warm-up outside of the tee before your turn.
- Preselect and prepare the striker you intend to use.
- Limit to a maximum of 2 practice swings, broken tees should be placed into the designated area.



On the fairway

- Approach your ball at a determined pace.
- As you approach the ball, plan the stroke and select the striker.
- Strike up to 2 practice swings. Also keep an eye on the balls of fellow players.
- Always hit a temporary (provisional) ball if the original may be lost or is off the field.
- If at any stage you have reached the double par, pick up your ball and move on.

On the green

- Park your golf cart behind or next to the green, on the side closer to the next tee.
- Correct your own pitchmarks, do not step on other players' rolling line.
- Place softly the flag to the green, further away from the rolling line.
- Plan your throwing direction while other players are rolling.
- Immediately remove your ball from the whole after you scored in and do not use your bat to remove your ball from the whole.
- Once you have finished place the flag back and immediately leave the green.
- Fill in the score card on the next tee.

At the course in general

- The player can only play the course sections in order. It is strictly forbidden to play golf course sections differently from the order of the courses!
- It is forbidden to practice on the golf course.
- Do not hunt for abandoned balls.
- Limit the ball search time to 3 minutes.
- Place back knocked out lawns, rake bunkers, repair ball marks.
- Do not play on areas marked with blue pales and with the sign "area under reconditioning".
- Follow the signs on the posted signs and comply with staff requests.
- Playing with a range ball, stealing a range ball, and playing without authorization on a given course (lack of green fee or annual membership), practice is punishable by an immediate fine, and a second time exclusion from the entire golf club area.
- Do not cross the area between a green and a bunker close to it or a water hazard close to it by trolley or by golf cart.
- Keep it clean! Do not throw rubbish or stumps on the field, remove it from the striker and the green area. Collect garbage left by others as well. For smokers, we recommend an ashtray that can be attached to a golf bag.



COACHING

- At Continental Citygolf Club only the contracted partners can provide training.
- Any activity that seems like training will be considered as training.

SECURITY RULES

To protect safe play and the physical integrity of others, please observe the following:

- If you lose sight of the ball hit, warn others with a "fore" shout.
- If you hear a "fore" shout, do not look around just bend over, protect your head with your hands.
- Know the average batting distance of the striker.
- Always stand away from the person just hitting.
- Do not approach a player who is swinging, keep distance.
- Do not stroke on par 3 until the previous flight or player has left the stage. On Par 4 do not stroke while the forward going flight or player is within strike distance.

DISCOUNTS & PRIZES

- Before purchasing discounted services, the staff of the golf complex has the right to request a document supporting eligibility for the discount. If the guest refuses to present the document, he is not entitled to the discount.
